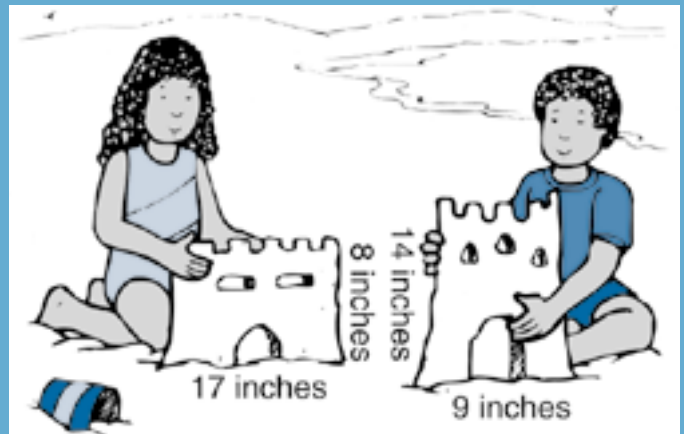


# At the Beach

Then the three of them walked to the beach. They swam and made sand castles.




1. The family walked to and from the beach. How many blocks did they walk in all?

4. The family ate five sandwiches. How many sandwiches were left?
5. They ate 4 pieces of fruit. How much fruit was left?
6. Toby drank 3 cans of juice. Each can held 6 ounces. How many ounces of juice did Toby drink? Explain how you found your answer.

# Truck Driving

Jack Smith drives a truck and trailer. The truck has 6 tires. The trailer has 8 tires.

Jack also helps take out boxes from his truck. He gets paid by the hour. He writes down his hours every day.

3. Last Friday, Jack drove for 9 hours. He moved boxes for 3 hours. How many hours in all did he work?
4. How many hours did Jack drive on Wednesday?
5. How many tires are on Jack's truck and trailer in all?
6. This week, Jack worked a dozen hours on Thursday. He worked 3 hours less than that on Friday. How long did Jack work on Friday?
