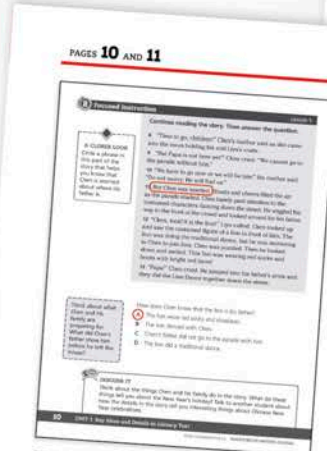
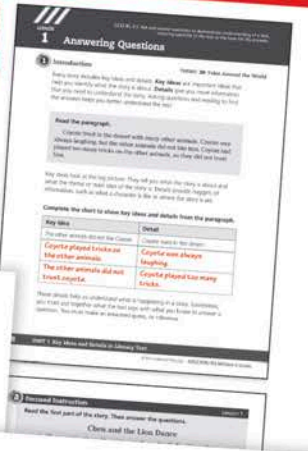

THEME: Tales Around the World

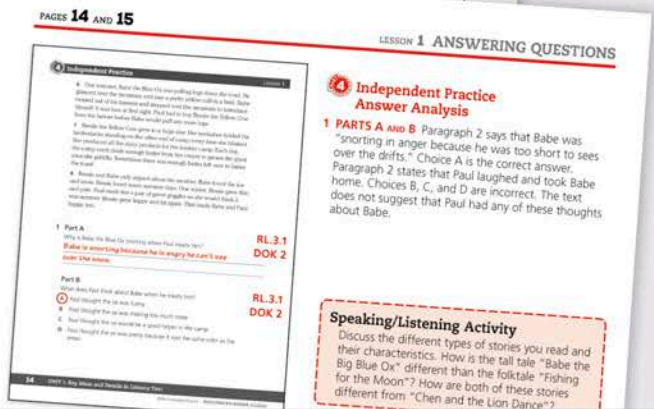
1 Introduction
